TOKYO, Japan (**January 7, 2016**) – Cabinet Office, Government of Japan, today announced the release of the Executive Summary (Final Report). This is an official summary of the international conference on cyber security, “Cyber<sup>3</sup> Conference Okinawa 2015—Crafting Security in a Less Secure World,” hosted by the Cabinet Office with the support of World Economic Forum over two days: November 7 and 8, 2015.
