## **SIGA HANOI 2015**

## ASEAN-JAPAN COOPERATION FOR A BETTER FUTURE THROUGH ALUMNI ACTIVITIES

The 27<sup>th</sup> SSEAYP International General Assembly (SIGA) was held at Hanoi and Ha Long Bay - Quang Ninh Province in Vietnam from the 23 to 26 April 2015 with the theme "ASEAN - Japan Cooperation for a better future through alumni activities".
