Around 50 automated driving experts in and outside Japan will present the latest policy trends, the results of Research and Development, and the examples of social implementation. Registration for participation is now open. Since the Workshop is held online, you can participate from all over the world, and SIP-adus looks forward to your registration.

## 1. Background

In the second phase of the Cross-Ministerial Strategic Innovation Promotion Program — Automated Driving for Universal Services (hereinafter, "SIP-adus"), SIP-adus workshop 2021 will be carried out to push forward international cooperation, in sharing information on common issues, establishing global standards, and collaborating researches. Key persons and specialists in the automated driving system from all over the world will introduce the latest research and development trends and social implementation efforts in their countries, including SIP-adus activities, in virtual conference. SIP-adus Workshop has been held every year since 2014, and this is the 8<sup>th</sup>, which is one of the widely recognized international conferences on automated driving.
