Summary of the Science and Technology Ministers' Round Table Meeting

October 7, 2007

A Science and Technology Ministers' Roundtable Meeting was held at the Kyoto International Conference Center on October 7, with the participation of science and technology ministers and officials in similar positions from 25 countries around the world. (The list of participants is in Attachment 1.) The participants exchanged views on the future international cooperation for science and technology for the sake of the solution on the global scale issues.

Matters discussed at the Ministers' Roundtable Meeting included desirable forms of international science and technology cooperation for the resolution of issues involved i) International collaboration on preventing global warming, ii) Capacity building for science and technology in developing countries, iii) Research and development for infectious diseases. These and other such matters were approached from the perspective of what science and technology can do toward the resolution to the global scale issues. As a result of the exchanges of views on these issues, the participants reached a shared awareness of the following:

- (1) They consider it crucial that particular steps be taken to reinforce international cooperation on research in light of their awareness that science and technology will have an extremely large role to play in measures to resolve common issues faced by humankind, including infectious disease and global warming resulting from climate change.
- (2) They consider it crucial that measures be taken to augment capacity building for science and technology to promote sustainable growth in the developing countries while simultaneously engaging in cooperation among advanced and developing countries to address the global scale issues.

In addition, a view was expressed on the importance of making a plan for the future actions.
