The European Union

500 million people - 28 countries - a single market*



- 7% of the World's population
- 24% of world expenditure on research
- 32% of high-impact publications
- 32% of patent applications

HORIZON 2020: Key part of EU's Multiannual Financial Framework (2014-2020)

1. Smart & inclusive growth (€451 billion)



- 2. Sustainable growth, natural resources (€373 billion)
- 3. Security and citizenship (€16 billion)
- 4. Global Europe (€58 billion)
- 5. Administration (€61.6 billion)

TOTAL €960 billion





Active involvement of stakeholders

- EU Presidencies: Sweden (societal challenges-based approach), Spain (integration of research and innovation), Hungary (FP7 interim evaluation), Poland (widening participation), European Council conclusions from 4.2.2011 (Common Framework to bring together all EU research and innovation funding)
- European Parliament reports: Merkies (Innovation Union), Audy (FP7 evaluation), Matias (Horizon 2020) and Carvalho (simplification)
- Overwhelming response to the public consultation on Horizon 2020 (more than 2000 contributions)
- Survey on administrative costs for participants in FP7
- > 25 workshops on the content of Horizon 2020





WHAT IS HORIZON 2020?

- A €80 billion research and innovation funding program (2014 -2020)
- A response to economic crisis by investing in future jobs and growth
- It addresses people's concerns about their livelihoods, safety and environment






Horizon 2020

- Simplified access: for all companies, universities, institutes in all EU countries and beyond
- > Open to the world:










HORIZON 2020 BUDGET (EUR 78.6 billion, current prices)
