Opening

- Reaffirming the vision and value of the letter of intention signed on May 5th 2015 in Paris.
- Ensuring the continuity of cooperation between France and Japan on nuclear emergency preparedness and response.

Overarching Concern

3. Discussion

- KI distribution / UPZ
- France; Exercises observation at Crisis Centers at National level or Local Level, decision making and not exercises including residents
- France; At the National level, a 6 month crisis management training programme has been developped. 150 high level people at the inter-ministerial level are trained each year to be able to face any kind of crisis. Specific skills are developped wether people will be working in the decision making room, the

situation room or the anticipation room.

- Contribute to carrier?
- Thinking training; How to modify. Who are the experts during emergency? How to respond?
- How to involve local residents in the full scale drill in Japan
- NRA decides recommendation but there are other factors to consider.

- To invite exercises and drills
 - France to invite Japan
 - 26 Nov. 2019 Chooz (ASN, IRSN crisis center, local prefecture)
 - 23 Jun. 2020 Civaux
 - Japan to invite France
 - Nov. 2019 Shimane
- Further information exchange on technical areas of mutual interest
 - KI distribution: possibly a workshop to exchange information
 - Whole process of decision making from TSO, safety authorities, national and local level: share similarities and differences between both countries
 - OIL or dose: discussion by experts
 - Public acceptance: communication strategy on how to interact with the public
 - Long term recovery and decision making to return to the area
- Taking the advantage of both Embassies as a possible communication channel as needed
- Taking note of the ongoing cooperation between IRSN and JAEA
 - JAEA hosted a workshop at its Paris Office on 15 February 2018
 - IRSN to visit Japan November 2019 for monitoring Fukushima area (technical level cooperation)
- Taking note of the ongoing cooperation between ASN and NRA

- to keep cooperation through annual meeting as appropriate,
- to swiftly exchange information on specific technical item in need, and

- to mutually invite respective drills and exercises.
