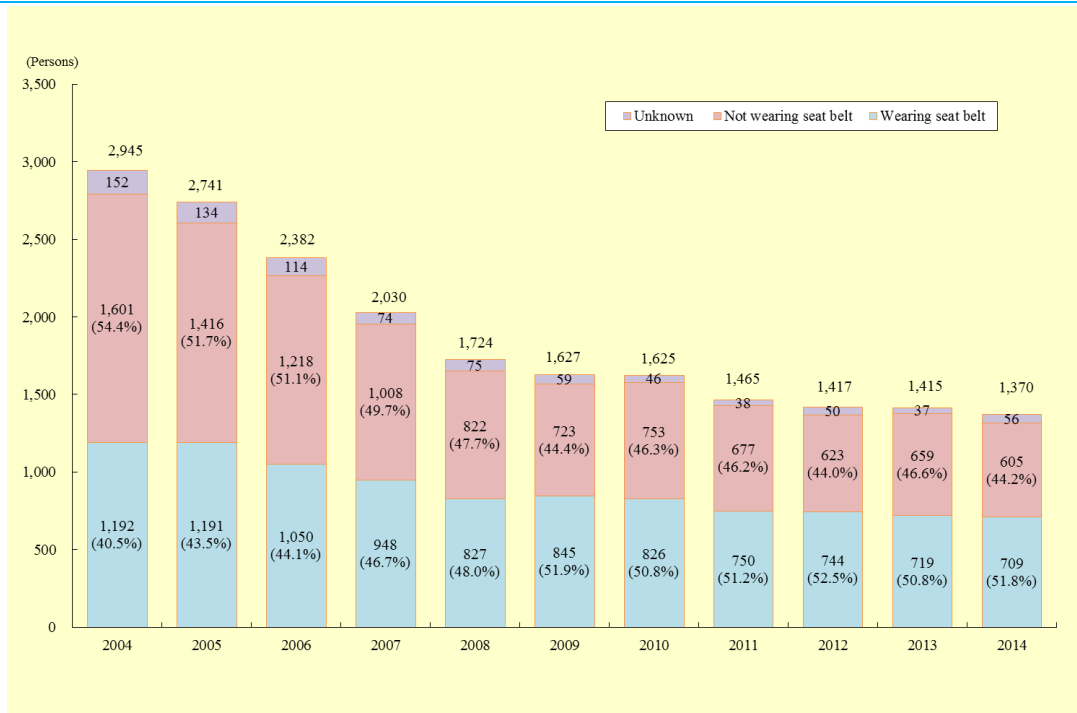


● **Number of Fatalities with or without the Use of Seat-belt**

- ① In terms of the number of fatalities while riding in a car with or without the use of a seat-belt in 2014, that without the use was 605 people, which was a decrease by 54 people (8.2%).
- ② The fatality rate of people not wearing seat belts (percentage of fatalities over the number of casualties) is 14.3 times as high as that of people wearing them.

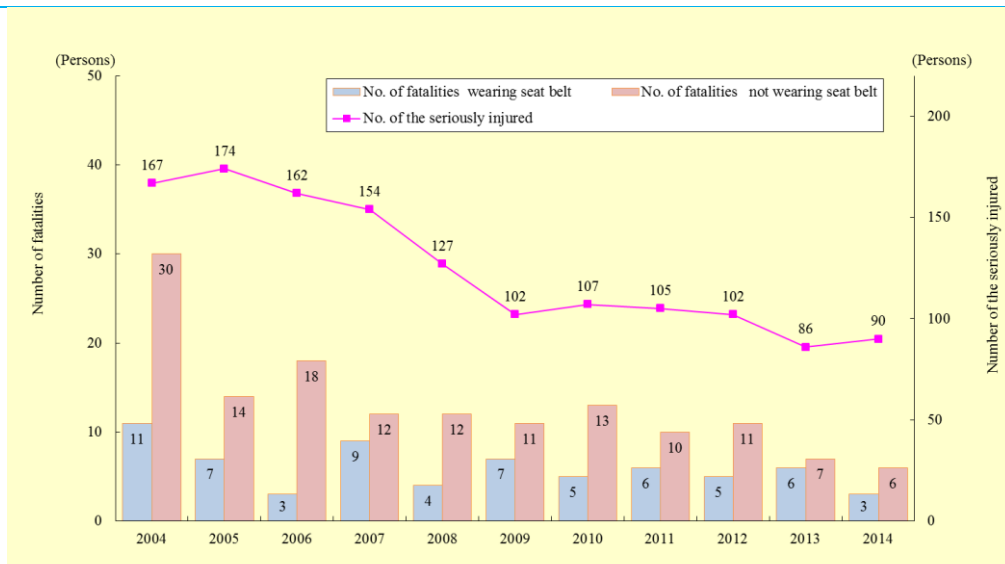
Changes in the number of fatalities with or without the use of seat-belts while riding in a car

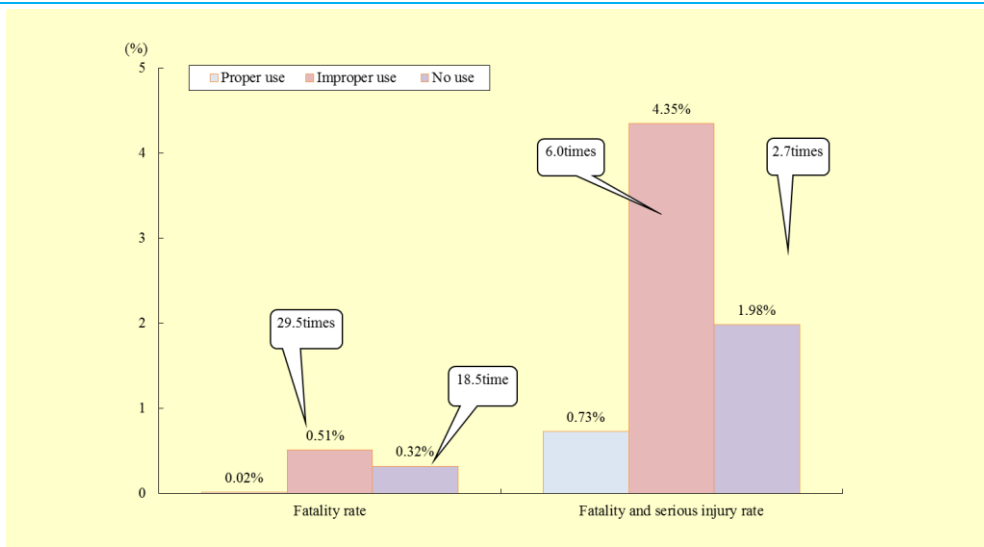
- Number of Fatalities with or without the Use of Child-seats
  - ① The number of fatalities of children under 6 years old while driven in a car was 9 (3 used child seats) and the number of serious injuries was 90.
  - ② The fatality and serious injury rate of children under 6 years old not using a child-seat is 2.7 times and using it improperly is 6.0 times as high as those who use it properly.
