
## • Number of Fatalities with or without the Use of Seat-belt

- ① In terms of the number of fatalities while riding in a car with or without the use of a seat-belt in 2014, that without the use was 605 people, which was a decrease by 54 people (8.2%).
- <sup>(2)</sup> The fatality rate of people not wearing seat belts (percentage of fatalities over the number of casualties) is 14.3 times as high as that of people wearing them.



- Number of Fatalities with or without the Use of Child-seats
  - ① The number of fatalities of children under 6 years old while driven in a car was 9 (3 used child seats) and the number of serious injuries was 90.
  - <sup>(2)</sup> The fatality and serious injury rate of children under 6 years old not using a child-seat is 2.7 times and using it improperly is 6.0 times as high as those who use it properly.
