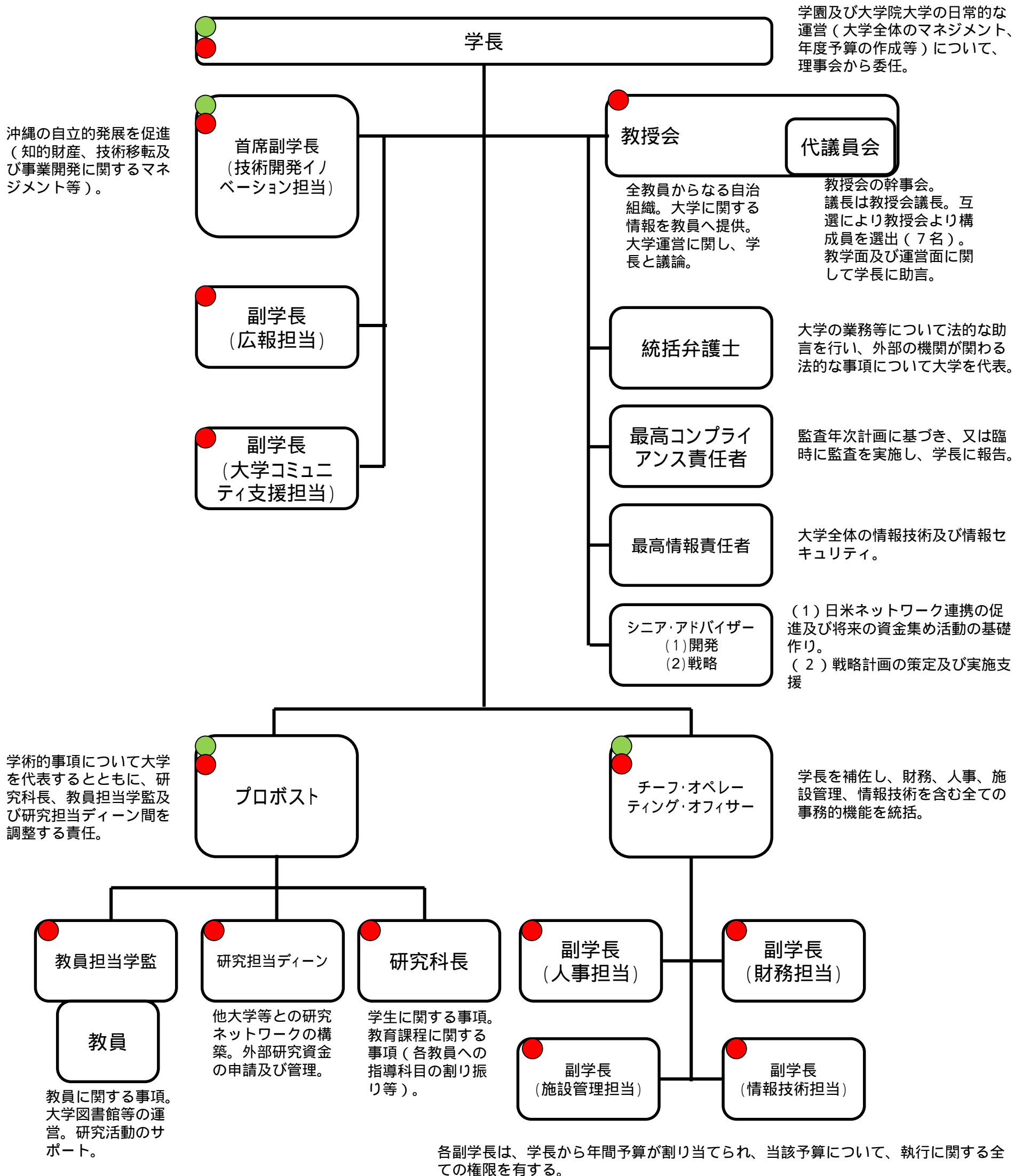


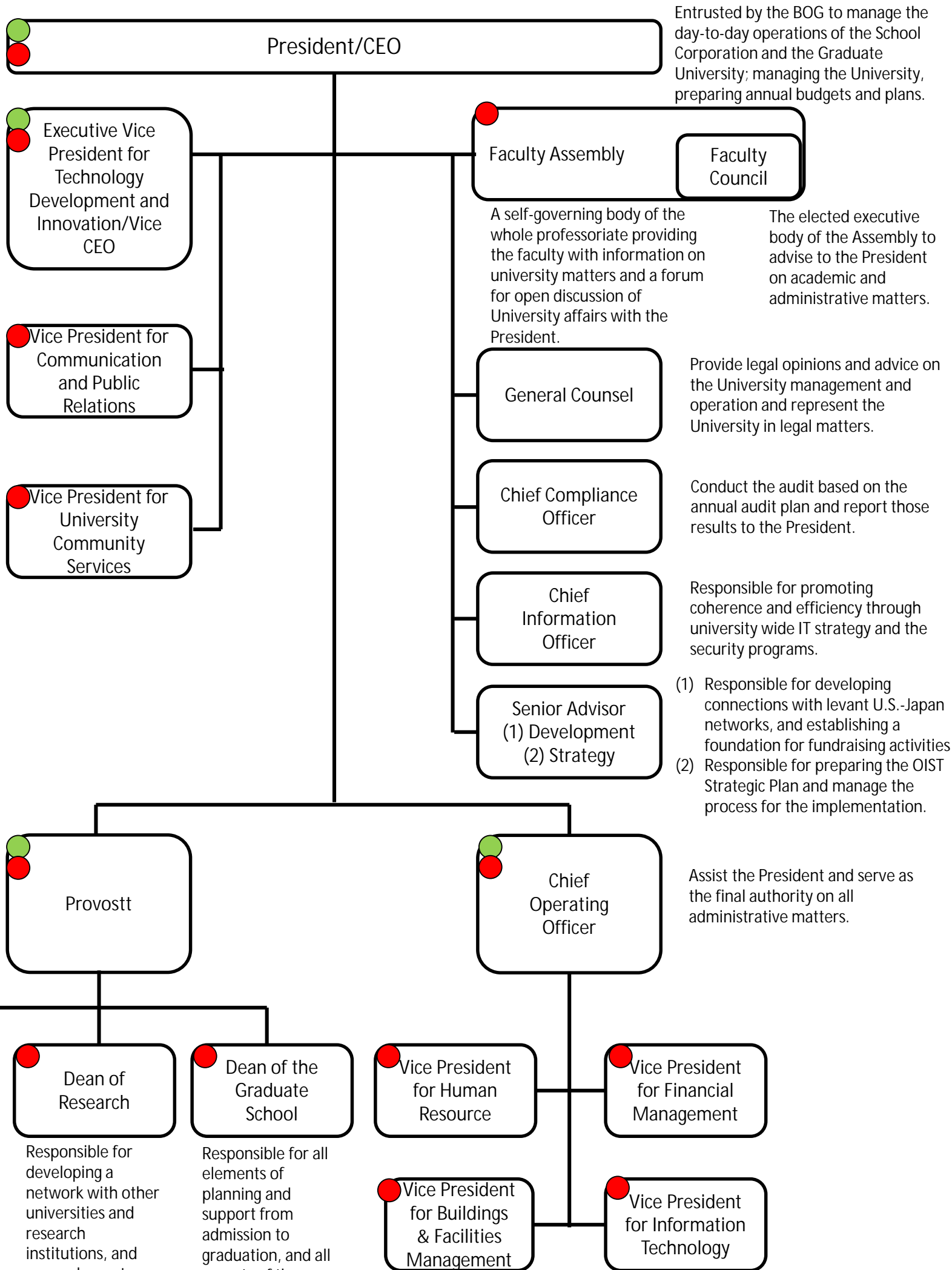
沖縄科学技術大学院大学：組織体制

Okinawa Institute of Science and Technology Graduate University : Organization Structure



Manage intellectual property, technology transfer and business development, contributing to the self-sustaining development of Okinawa.

Entrusted by the BOG to manage the day-to-day operations of the School Corporation and the Graduate University; managing the University, preparing annual budgets and plans.

The elected executive body of the Assembly to advise to the President on academic and administrative matters.

Provide legal opinions and advice on the University management and operation and represent the University in legal matters.

Conduct the audit based on the annual audit plan and report those results to the President.

Responsible for promoting coherence and efficiency through university wide IT strategy and the security programs.

- (1) Responsible for developing connections with levant U.S.-Japan networks, and establishing a foundation for fundraising activities
- (2) Responsible for preparing the OIST Strategic Plan and manage the process for the implementation.

Represent the University for academic and research matters through interdepartmental coordination between the Dean of Graduate School, the DFA and the DOR.

Assist the President and serve as the final authority on all administrative matters.

Responsible for administration of general matters concerning the faculty such as faculty search and appointments, research unit reviews, tenure reviews, etc.

Responsible for developing a network with other universities and research institutions, and research grant applications and management.

Responsible for all elements of planning and support from admission to graduation, and all aspects of the curriculum.

Each Vice President is assigned an annual budget with full authority to administer the budget for which they are held responsible by the President.

- Upper Management Meetings: Composed of the President, Executive Vice President, Provost and COO, weekly held to monitor and facilitate implementation of those matters decided by the President.
- Executive Committee meetings: Composed of the President, EVP, Provost, COO, all the VPs and Deans, Chair of the Faculty Council, biweekly held to promote a decision-making process on important matters on University operation, education and research by assigning responsible member with specific implementation schedules.
