MEMORANDUM FOR: IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

THROUGH : Central Liaison Office, Tokyo.

SUBJECT : Custody, Control and Protective Maintenance of Japanese Aircraft Plants, Arsenals and Laboratories.

1. The Imperial Japanese Government is notified that the Japanese aircraft plants, Army and Navy arsenals and laboratories designated on the attached lists are hereby being taken into the custody and control of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. Within seventy-two (72) hours of the time of receipt of this memorandum, the Japanese Government will have qualified representatives of that Government report to the Commanding General, Eighth United States Army, and the Commander, Fifth United States Fleet, to receive instructions in regard to specific plants and installations affected and measures which will be taken to effect custody and control. Of the plants and other installations listed in Inclosure No. 1 (attached) the Commander Fifth United States Fleet will have custody of the Yokosuka Naval Arsenal, the Yokosuka Naval Yard Laboratory and the Yokosuka Navy Yard Workman Training School at Yokosuka City, Kanegawa Prefecture. All other plants and installations listed in Inclosure No. 1 will be under the custody of the Commanding General, Eighth United States Army.

3. It is directed that the Imperial Japanese Government make available to the Commanding General, Eighth Army and The Commander, Fifth Fleet, all personnel, equipment and supplies deemed necessary by them for the establishment of proper custody and control, and protective maintenance.

4. You will take action to stop immediately all removals of machinery and equipment from the above-designated plants and installations. No further removals will be permitted without the specific authority of the Commanding General, Eighth Army or the Commander, Fifth Fleet.

5. All permits which have been issued for conversion of listed aircraft plants, arsenals and laboratories to civilian consumer production will be subjected to review by the Commanding General, Eighth Army and the Commander, Fifth Fleet.

Within seventy-two (72) hours of the time of receipt of this memorandum, the Japanese Government will have qualified representatives of that Government report to the Commanding General, Eighth United States Army, and the Commander, Fifth United States Fleet, to receive instructions in regard to specific plants and installations affected and measures which will be taken to effect custody and control. Of the plants and other installations listed in Inclosure No. 1 (attached) the Commander Fifth United States Fleet will have custody of the Yokosuka Naval Arsenal, the Yokosuka Naval Yard, Laboratory and the Yokosuka Navy Yard Workman Training School at Yokosuka City, Kanagawa Prefecture. All other plants and installations listed in Inclosure No. 1 will be under the custody of the Commanding General, Eighth United States Army.

3. It is directed that the Imperial Japanese Government make available to the Commanding General, Eighth Army and the Commander, Fifth Fleet, all personnel, equipment and supplies deemed necessary by them for the establishment of proper custody and control, and protective maintenance.

4. You will take action to stop immediately all removals of machinery and equipment from the above-designated plants and installations. No further removals will be permitted without the specific authority of the Commanding General, Eighth Army or the Commander, Fifth Fleet.

5. All permits which have been issued for conversion of listed aircraft plants, arsenals and laboratories to civilian consumer production will be subjected to review by the Commanding General, Eighth Army and the Commander, Fifth Fleet.

6. Acknowledgement of receipt of this memorandum is directed.

Of the plants and other installations listed in Inclosure No. 1 (attached) the Commander Fifth United States Fleet will have custody of the Yokosuka Naval Arsenal, the Yokosuka Naval Yard Laboratory and the Yokosuka Navy Yard Workman Training School at Yokosuka City, Kanagawa Prefecture. All other plants and installations listed in Inclosure No. 1 will be under the custody of the Commanding General, Eighth United States Army.

3. It is directed that the Imperial Japanese Government make available to the Commanding General, Eighth Army and The Commander, Fifth Fleet, all personnel, equipment and supplies deemed necessary by them for the establishment of proper custody and control, and protective maintenance.

4. You will take action to stop immediately all removals of machinery and equipment from the above-designated plants and installations. No further removals will be permitted without the specific authority of the Commanding General, Eighth Army or the Commander, Fifth Fleet.

5. All permits which have been issued for conversion of listed aircraft plants, arsenals and laboratories to civilian consumer production will be subjected to review by the Commanding General, Eighth Army and The Commander, Fifth Fleet.

1. Reference is made to C.L.O. Memorandum No. 1397 (5.1) dated 27 December 1945, subject: "Transactions of the Properties held Abroad," and Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 130 (22 Sept 45) ESS, subject: "Control of Financial Transactions."

2. The Imperial Japanese Government is authorized to permit the succession by inheritance to the ownership of property held abroad by persons in Japan in accordance with established succession laws of Japan. In all such cases the Ministry of Finance will require the person succeeding to the ownership to report the property as an external asset as directed by Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 123 (6 Oct 45) ESS, subject: "Reports of Foreign Exchange Assets and Related Matters," unless such a report has previously been filed by a former owner of the property. In that case an amendment to the report, previously filed, will be submitted specifying the name and address of the person succeeding to the ownership of the property and the name and address of the former owner who filed the original report.

3. The Imperial Japanese Government is also authorized to permit change of the place of registration of Japanese Government bonds from places outside of Japan to places in Japan, by individuals in Japan, provided that the amount of bonds, the place of registration of which is changed, does not exceed 1,000 yen for any individual. The request to permit similar changes in place of registration of debentures of Japanese private enterprises is not approved.

4. The Imperial Japanese Government is authorized to permit payment of salaries and allowances to officials or employees of Japanese concerns who were formerly employed abroad but are now in Japan, provided that the accounts of offices or branches outside of Japan are not debited with the amount of the disbursements and provided that the assets of the concerns in Japan are in excess of total liabilities to branches and offices outside of Japan. The request to permit the repayment in Japan of money, deposited by such officials or employees in Japanese offices or branches outside of Japan, is not approved.

5. The request for permission to allow the importation into Japan of deposit pass books issued by branch offices abroad of Japanese banks is denied except insofar as postal savings and Army-Navy field-postal savings pass books may be imported in accordance with Memorandum for

2. a. The loans proposed in paragraphs 1(a) and 1(e) of LOF 21 and paragraph 1a of LOF 117 are not approved. These loans will be reconsidered and included, to the extent still deemed necessary, in the program required by paragraph 9 of reference 1c above.
  - b. No action will be taken on the request made in paragraph 1(b) of LOF 21 until a full explanation is submitted.
  - c. The loans proposed by paragraphs 1(c) and 1 (d) of LOF 21 and paragraph 1b(1) of LOF 117 were authorized by memorandum from this Headquarters, file AG 130 (13 Dec 45)ESS/FI, dated 13 December 1945, subject: "Government Borrowing".
  - d. The loan proposed by paragraph 1b(2) of LOF 117 is hereby authorized in accordance with paragraph 7a(2) of reference 1c above.

THROUGH : Central Liaison Office, Tokyo.

SUBJECT : Reduction of Government Borrowing and Expenditures.

1. Reference is made to memorandum this Headquarters, file AG 121.7 (24 Nov 45) ESS/FI, dated 24 November 1945, subject: "Elimination of War Profits and Reorganization of National Finances", and particularly to the provisions of paragraph 8 thereof which prohibited the Imperial Japanese Government, its sub-divisions, agencies or instrumentalities from issuing bonds or obtaining credit in any form except as authorized by this Headquarters.

2. It is noted that requests for approval of government borrowing, submitted in accordance with reference memorandum, propose a continuance of government expenditures at a high rate and the financing of the resulting deficit principally by sale of government bonds to the Bank of Japan, with resultant expansion of bank credit. To avoid the inflationary effect of such a policy, the Imperial Japanese Government will henceforth adhere to the following fiscal principles:

a. Government expenditures will be reduced to the absolute minimum essential to carry on necessary functions of government.

b. Government deficits will be financed to the fullest extent possible by borrowing from the current savings of the people through the agencies already existing for the collection of such savings.

c. Recourse to the resources of the ordinary banks and the Bank of Japan for financing deficits of the Imperial Japanese Government and its agencies or instrumentalities will be made only as a last resort. This restriction will not apply to the discount or rediscount of short-term government instruments, such as food certificates, issued directly in payment for goods or services.

3. The provisions of paragraph 2 above will apply to all government borrowing authorized by this Headquarters since 24 November 1945, including, but not limited to, those authorized by the following memoranda:

BASIC: Memo for Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 130 (21 Jan 46 ),  
ESS/FI, dtd 21 Jan 46 subject: "Government Borrowing".

e. The loans proposed by paragraphs 1(f) of LCF 21 and 1c of LCF 117 are hereby authorized in accordance with paragraph 8b of reference 1c above.

f. The loans proposed by paragraph 1d of LCF 117 will be re-considered and included, to the extent still deemed necessary, in the program required by paragraph 9 of reference 1c above.

4. Effective immediately, the practice of financing the current deficit of the Imperial Japanese Government by overdraft on the government account with the Bank of Japan will cease. Upon receipt of this memorandum, a report of the approximate amount of such overdraft will be furnished this Headquarters. Thereafter that amount will not be increased except for payments already in process by branches and agencies of the Bank of Japan at the time of receipt of this memorandum. As soon as practicable thereafter, a final report will be submitted, showing the amount of the overdraft after all payments now in process have been completed. Application for funding of such amount by the issue of government bonds may then be submitted to this Headquarters.

5. a. No further borrowing for, nor payments from, the Special Account for War Expenses will be made, except those already in process as indicated in paragraph 4 above. Future payments of the types which have heretofore been made from the Special Account for War Expenses and which have not been prohibited by this Headquarters and are not required to be made into blocked accounts, may be made from the General Account. Before any such payments are made, however, a detailed estimate of the amount needed for the remainder of the fiscal year 1945-46 will be submitted to this Headquarters. Revenues which have heretofore accrued to the Special Account for War Expenses will hereafter be credited to the General Account.

b. Final settlement of the Special Account for War Expenses, including adjustment of records to conform with the provisions of paragraph 8 below, will be effected as rapidly as possible. A detailed report will be submitted to this Headquarters showing the final status of the account.

6. For the period from 1 January 1946 through 31 March 1946, the total of all payments from the General Account, including transfers to Special Accounts but not including payments authorized by paragraph 5a above, will not exceed an average of ¥2,000,000,000 per month without prior authorization by this Headquarters. Any request for such authorization will include a detailed estimate of total General Account payments for the remainder of the fiscal year, showing the amount needed for each major purpose. Immediate steps will be taken to effect the necessary economies.

7. a. Permission is hereby granted the Imperial Japanese Government and its agencies and instrumentalities to borrow for the following purposes without specific authorization from this Headquarters in each case:

BASIC: Memo to Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 121(21 Jan 46)ESS/FI, dtd 21 Jan 46 subject: "Reduction of Government Borrowing and Expenditures".

- (1) Working capital for government enterprises and activities which are completely self-sustaining from their own sources of income, exclusive of government grants or subsidies in any form.
- (2) Short-term refinancing of debts presently outstanding.
- (3) Sales of savings debentures and similar securities directly to the public, where the total of any one issue does not exceed ¥50,000,000.

b. The provisions of paragraph 2 will apply to loans made under the authority of this paragraph.

c. A report of loans made under authority of this paragraph will be included in the weekly report of the Minister of Finance.

8. a. A new Special Account will be created for all payments made by the Imperial Japanese Government under authority of paragraph 4 of Memorandum this Headquarters, file AG 121.7(24 Nov 45) ESS/FI, dated 24 November 1945, subject: "Elimination of War Profits and Reorganization of National Finances". The unreleased balance of all government payments heretofore made into blocked accounts will be transferred to the new Special Account from the budget accounts from which they were originally paid.

b. Creation of government debt equal in amount to the total payments hereafter made from the new account is hereby authorized. Government debt for payments previously made into blocked accounts will be transferred to the new Special account from the budget accounts where it has previously been carried. The debt authorized by this sub-paragraph will bear no interest.

c. Sums needed for actual payments or withdrawals from blocked accounts will be transferred from the General Account.

9. The Imperial Japanese Government will submit to this Headquarters, as soon as practicable, a new government borrowing program for the remainder of the fiscal year 1945-46, based on the provisions of this memorandum. Borrowing authorized by paragraphs 7 and 8 above need not be included, except that an estimate of the total proceeds of sales under paragraph 7c is desired.

SUBJECT : Establishment of an Effective System for Narcotic Control in Japan.

1. You are directed to enact legislation embodying the following provisions for the establishment of an effective system for narcotic control in Japan:
  - a. All persons lawfully entitled to deal in narcotics will be properly registered, licensed, and classified.
  - b. Dealers will be required to re-register annually.
  - c. Dealers will be required to submit an inventory of narcotic stocks on hand when registering or re-registering.
  - d. Dealers will be required to submit periodical reports of narcotic transactions and stocks on hand to the Imperial Japanese Government.
  - e. All transactions in narcotics will be in or from original stamped packages which you will provide for in your enactment.
  - f. Limitations of sales by the several classes of registrants will be set forth in your enactment.
  - g. Sales between registrants will be by means of order forms which you will record and provide in blank to registrants.
  - h. Except as provided in your enactment any person who is not registered, licensed and classified will be prohibited from having narcotics in his possession.
  - i. Severe penalties will be provided for any person who violates the provisions of your enactment.
2. You will submit a copy of the law in English to this Headquarters prior to enactment.

The Swiss Legation presents its compliments to the General Headquarters of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers and begs to acknowledge receipt of the memorandum No. AG 091.1 (14 Jan 46)CS of January 14th together with its enclosures, notes G029/P4 and G01/P4 of December 8th and January 4th from the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and concerning the protection of the Japanese interests in Sweden, Eire, Portugal and Afghanistan.

The Legation has taken good note of the rectification mentioned in the above communications from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. It points out, however, that, as the Legation had let know in its notes of December 29th, January 7th, 8th and 10th to the General Headquarters, the Swiss Government has decided not to assume representation of new Japanese interests nor to continue the representation of those Japanese interests entrusted to Switzerland.

The Legation would be grateful if the General Headquarters would transmit the above to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
