1. The Central Liaison Office is directed to investigate and report on the present location and condition of the Filipiniana Library, the property of Mr. E. D. Hester, Economic Adviser, American Embassy, Manila, removed during the Japanese occupation of the Philippine Islands.

2. The subject library consisted of approximately 2,000 bound volumes, many of which were individual titles and others bound volumes of books and reports. Inclosed is a copy of the dry seal mark, giving the owner's name, which appeared in each of the volumes.

3. The subject books were located in the following places at the time of the Japanese occupation:

a. Approximately 50 volumes were at the owner's office, R-102, United States High Commissioner's residence, Dewey Boulevard, Manila;

b. Approximately 800 volumes were in the main library of the United States High Commissioner's residence;

c. The remaining volumes were at the owner's residence, 1112 Dewey Boulevard, Manila.

It is known that Mr. Hester's residence was occupied by the Nippon Army Press Association during the major portion of the occupation.

4. The required report, which is to include a catalogue in sextuplicate of all available volumes, is to be submitted to the Civil Property Custodian by 10 July 1947.

2. Paragraph 3 of reference 1a above is changed to read as follows:

"8. Authorization is given to manufacture motor trucks, three hundred (300) small passenger vehicles annually of 1500 CC piston displacement or under and for the assembly of fifty (50) large-sized passenger vehicles."

3. Paragraph 4 of reference 1b above is changed to read as follows:

"4. Except for the assembly of fifty (50) large-sized passenger cars, the manufacture of passenger cars with piston displacement of greater than 1500 CC is denied."

4. No raw materials currently allocated for small truck manufacture are to be used for passenger car manufacture.

Moreover, this memorandum shall not be construed as approval for priority for raw materials, equipment or facilities to be used in the manufacture of small-sized passenger cars.

5. Private use of these small vehicles is prohibited. Sale for official use and distribution can be made only to the following organizations or individuals: Hospitals, doctors, police, government agencies, public organizations, business firms and taxicab companies. Sale of the fifty (50) large-sized passenger cars authorized only to the Japanese Board of Trade for use as taxicabs for the transportation of accredited commercial representatives of foreign governments and foreign business firms.

6. The Japanese Government is further directed to submit to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, by the twentieth (20th) of each month a report covering the period of the preceding month and incorporating the following:

- a. Production of cars during the month by all producers in Japan.
- b. Distribution of production by regions.
- c. Name and type of organization or name of individual receiving the vehicles.

This report will be typed in English on 8" x 11" paper.

2. The policy and plans for rationing of petroleum products, as submitted under reference 1b above, are satisfactory in principle but are not sufficiently complete in detail. It is suggested that the following be included in the policy and plans and in accordance with the provisions of Cabinet Instructions No. 3:
 - a. Definitions of the following be more complete and detailed:
 - (1) Rationing evidence.
 - (2) Authorized dealer.
 - (3) Legitimate consumer.
 - b. Strict and detailed restriction on the delivery of petroleum products without proper exchange or display of valid rationing evidence.
 - c. Requirement that dealer must sell to authorized consumer upon presentation of valid rationing evidence and at legal prices, these prices to be properly displayed by all dealers.
 - d. Detailed narrative description of rationing evidences.
 - e. Requirement that upon registration, dealers must report their trade area, their sales during a preselected period, the inventory on hand as of inventory date, and storage capacity (bulk or packaged).

f. Provision for the assignment of an allowable inventory for each dealer based upon registration report data and the percentage allowance of the prefectural or area allowable inventory.

g. Provision for the issuance of bulk delivery certificate at the beginning of rationing to permit establishment of a working stock of petroleum products. The allowable inventory to be established on the basis of economical shipping units and such additional quantities above the actual allowable inventory as to provide economical shipping units be adjusted over a period of time and that accountability for this overage be required.

h. Reports from retailer to Japanese Government be timed so as to permit issuance of bulk certificates to retailers in amounts corresponding to sales to permit replacement of stocks sold. It is believed that no more than one month's lag in time will be required.

i. Strict prohibition against the purchase, sale or transfer of rationing evidence.

j. Provision for appeal to the Economic Stabilization Board by any claimant who feels his case has been unjustly handled by local authorities.

k. Strict and specific provisions for enforcement of the proposed plan.

l. Provision for rationing evidence and identification of chauffeurs for fleet owners who operate their own petroleum facilities.

m. Statement that the plan for gasoline also includes lubricating oil and greases required for transportation equipment.

n. Provision that authorized consumers will be provided with rationing evidences without cost.

3. The revised plan incorporating provisions outlined in paragraph 2 above will be submitted to the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers for approval by 15 June 1947.
