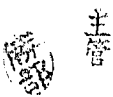

1. Appendix "A" contains a list of Japanese merchant vessels which are to be considered as total losses, available for stripping and reduction to scrap for the benefit of the Japanese economy.
2. This memorandum in no way authorizes payment of insurance claims on any of the vessels listed.
3. The period of sixty days from the date of this memorandum is allowed to owners of these vessels to present through the Imperial Japanese Government, Ministry of Transportation to Commander Naval Forces, Japan, any requests for exclusion from the list inclosed of any vessels now under salvage or whose salvage and repair may appear possible.
4. After the sixty-day period no applications for salvage of these ships in their entirety will be approved except for purposes of scrapping, and all vessels will be stricken from the lists of Japanese shipping.
5. A quarterly report of vessels being scrapped under these provisions shall be furnished by the Imperial Japanese Government to Commander Naval Forces, Japan, with whom direct communication is authorized in this matter.

The Swedish Diplomatic Mission in Japan presents its compliments to the Imperial Ministry for Foreign Affairs and, referring to the latter's note verbale No. 26/R.J., has the honour to state that it is gratifying to note that the Imperial Ministry - through family correspondence recently received by some people in Japan from relatives and friends in Brazil - has, at last, become aware that the disturbances among Japanese citizens in Brazil were of such nature as reported in this Mission's notes verbales BB-148/46 dated 24th April, 1946, BB-255/46 dated 26th July, 1946, BB-288/46 dated 21st August, 1946, and BB-305/46 of 13th September, 1946, which insistantly pointed out the situation and suggested urgent action on the part of the Imperial Government. This Mission is highly surprised that the said notes verbales did

not arouse the said awareness somewhat earlier which might have saved the Royal Legation in Brazil - as well as, of course, the Brazilian Government and the Japanese citizens involved - some inconvenience.

As desired, this Mission has now by cable requested the Swedish Government to inform in detail of the present situation of the Japanese residents in Brazil, and shall not fail to let the Imperial Ministry know as soon as a reply is at hand.

4. It is reported that T. Noguchi, 231 Ikegami Honmachi, Omori-ku, also claims a 30% interest in the land by reason of another loan and has started legal proceedings to enforce his agreement.

It is directed that the Japanese Government enact all necessary legislation to make unlawful the possession of British Armed Forces Special Vouchers and Australian one penny and one half-penny copper coins on and after 6 May 1947 by any person or organization except members of the Allied Occupation Forces and those specifically authorized by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers. Provisions for the confiscation of British Armed Forces special Vouchers and Australian penny and half-penny coins in the possession of unauthorized persons, or organizations, and appropriate punitive measures shall be included.

2. The Japanese Government shall treat British Armed Forces Special Vouchers and Australian penny and half-penny coins as neither legal tender, nor a lawful medium of exchange, and it shall turn over all such currency coming into its possession, custody, or control, to the Chief Paymaster, Headquarters, British Commonwealth Occupation Force, FUA JIMA, JAPAN.

3. As a matter of information it is advised that British Armed Forces Special Vouchers are in sterling values of the following denominations and general description:

RECEPTION CENTERS IN JAPAN FOR
PROCESSING REPATRIATES

1. The Ministry of Public Welfare, having been designated by the Japanese Government to handle repatriation matters will:

a. Establish a central agency to effect coordination with other Japanese governmental agencies regarding supply, customs, transportation, physical inspections, quarantine and demobilization, and to effect liaison with the headquarters of the Eighth United States Army.

b. Establish and operate reception centers at designated ports (see paragraph 2a) to:

(1) Receive, process, care for and evacuate all Japanese repatriates returning to Japan proper from overseas.

(2) Assemble, process, care for and load non-Japanese nationals, as outlined in Annex III.

c. Designate a resident director at each reception center responsible for its operation and for maintaining liaison with local Allied military authorities responsible for supervision of the reception center.
