b. File AG 386.6 (25 Jul 46)CFC/FP, SCAPIN 1083, 25 July 1946, subject, "Custody, Shipment and Storage of Looted Property";

c. File AG 386.6 (26 Sep 46)CFC/FP, SCAPIN 1783, 26 September 1947, subject, "Safeguarding Property Stored in Looted Property Warehouses in Japan";

d. File AG 386.3 (13 Feb 48)CFC/FP, SCAPIN 1858, 13 February 1948, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer and Delivery of Property being Restored to Claimant Nations under the Restitution Program".

2. The Japanese Government will immediately prepare the following buildings in the Kurihama Naval Ordnance Depot and the Osaka Arsenal for the storage of looted property to be concentrated in those areas:

b. The building known as "Joto No. 3 Turning Shop" at the Osaka Arsenal (this building will henceforth be known as the Osaka Arsenal Looted Property Warehouse).

The above buildings are in areas currently under control of Military Government Teams and will remain so, even though the looted property operations will be carried out by the Japanese Government.

SUBJECT: Petroleum Storage Tank Facilities

1. Reference is made to Memorandum for the Japanese Government, File AG 311.3 (6 Dec 47) 3000, SCAPIN 1330, dated 6 December 1947, subject same as above, as amended.
2. Radiotelephone calls between Japan and Colombia, as listed in enclosure 1 attached hereto, via the United States, are authorized effective 15 July 1948.
3. All provisions of SCAPIN 1330/2 applicable to calls between Japan and the points listed in enclosure 1 thereto will apply equally to calls between Japan and Colombia.
4. Direct communication between the Civil Communications Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, and the Ministry of Communications, regarding operating and accounting procedures within the scope of this memorandum, is authorized.

1. The Japanese Government is hereby directed to take such action as necessary to prevent construction, major repair, rehabilitation, dismantling, movement, or scrapping of any petroleum storage tank facilities in excess of 50 kiloliters capacity and their accessory equipment without prior approval of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
2. This directive does not modify or supersede Memorandum for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 600.3(30 Nov 46)CFC, SCAPIN 1370, dated 30 November 1946, subject: Preservation of Property in Japan Owned by United Nations and their Nationals.
3. It is further directed that a report be submitted to the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers providing the following information pertaining to storage tank capacity.
 - a. Location.
 - b. Ownership
 - c. User
 - d. Number and capacity of tanks
 - e. Purposes for which used
 - f. Type of tank
 - g. Present condition
4. The required report will be submitted prior to 1 September 1948.
5. Direct communication between the Economic and Scientific Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, and the Japanese Government is authorized.

SUBJECT: Report of Mission on Social Security in Japan

1. Pursuant to the request of the Japanese government and various private groups in Japan for advice and guidance with regard to social security, a special mission from the United States composed of individuals with considerable experience and knowledge in that field was invited by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers to visit Japan to survey, evaluate, and submit a report of conclusions and recommendations as would aid in achieving a sound social security program for the Japanese people.

2. A copy of the Report of the Social Security Mission is submitted herewith as a document of reference and guidance to the Japanese people in formulating and effectuating plans for reformation of their present social security structure. The maintenance of a comprehensive and adequate social security program based on democratic precepts and within the limits of the nation's resources is believed to be a desired goal for the Japanese nation.

3. The recommendations contained in the Report with reference to organizational structure and delegation of administrative responsibilities represent one possible approach to the problem. As a result of extensive study and experimentation, other approaches as well as the one contained in the Mission's Report have been developed and successfully applied in various parts of the world.

4. The specific procedures and programs for implementation of social security should be determined in the light of existing conditions in Japan and the needs of those groups in the Japanese community primarily interested.

5. Direct contact is authorized between the interested Staff Sections of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, and agencies in the Japanese government concerned with implementing plans of fundamental reformation of the program.

SUBJECT: Travel of Japanese Chaplains to Netherlands East Indies.

TO: Japanese Government

1. Reference is made to memorandum from the Japanese Government C.L.O. No. 5554(PWC) of 16 July 1947, which requested authorization to send three Christian Chaplains and three Buddhist Priests to engage in missionary services for Japanese war criminals and war crimes suspects detained in the Netherlands East Indies.

2. The Netherlands Military Mission has informed this Headquarters that the Japanese Government's request is not favorably considered by the Netherlands East Indies Government for the following reasons:

- a. There is an acute housing shortage in the Netherlands East Indies as the result of destruction and devastation caused by the war and the subsequent revolution.
- b. Chaplains, both European and Indonesian, of any religious denomination, have constant access to the detainees, and scrupulous care is taken to meet all their religious requirements.
- c. The visiting of various camps by Japanese chaplains would involve travel about the country, which, in view of the possible attitude of the population, might entail consequences which the Netherlands East Indies Government is not prepared to take.
- d. The number of Japanese detainees is rapidly decreasing, largely due to repatriation.

3. The Mission has informed this Headquarters that in September 1947 authorization was granted for the release of DOOKI Sato, a Japanese national formerly attached as a civilian to the Japanese Army, to work as a priest for the Japanese detainees.
