SUBJECT: Restitution of Three Vehicles Looted from
the Netherlands East Indies

1. Reference is made to memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 386.6 (13 Feb 48)CPC/FP, SCAPIN 1858, 13 February 1948, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer and Delivery of Property Being Restored to Claimant Nations under the Restitution Program," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. The Japanese Government is directed to restore the following vehicles to the Netherlands Government:

a. A 1941 De Soto sedan, engine No. S8-88160, CPC No. 1654, license No. F.V. 52, presently in the custody of the Hiroshima Prefectural Office of the Japanese Government

b. The following vehicles now in protective custody in the Osaka Looted Property Warehouse:

(1) A 1942 Dodge sedan, engine No. D22-16764, CPC No. B-3047

(2) A 1941 De Soto sedan, engine No. S10-10405, CPC No. 141.

3. The subject property will be delivered on 28 October 1948 at Kobe, Japan. Captain C. Meulemans Versteegh, 150 Yamamoto-dori, 3-chome, Kobe, who has been designated as the authorized representative of the Netherlands Government to receive and give receipt for the subject property is to be notified upon arrival of the vehicles and will inform the Japanese Government representative where delivery in restitution is to be effected.

4. The Japanese Government will designate by name an authorized representative to execute the receipt forms in its behalf and will notify General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers of his appointment on or before 20 October 1948.

SUBJECT: Radio Communications for the Japanese Whaling Fleet

1. Reference is made to:
 - a. Memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 676.3 (14 Jul 47) CCS, SCAPIN 1744, dated 14 July 1947, subject: Control of Radio Communications, as amended.
 - b. Memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 458 (25 Jun 48) GD, SCAPIN 5822-A, dated 15 July 1948, subject: Radar for Vessels of Antarctic Whaling Expedition 1948-49.
 - c. Memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 800.217 (21 Jun 48) NR/FI, SCAPIN 1913, dated 21 June 1948, subject: Japanese Whaling Operations in the Antarctic in the 1948-1949 Season.
2. The radio frequencies for use by the 1948-1949 Japanese Whaling Expedition will be as authorized in inclosure 1.
3. The Bureau of Fisheries of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry will act as the Communications Agent in Japan for all official messages to and from the whaling fleet including the Taiyo Gyogyo (Ocean Fishing Company), the Nippon Suisan (Marine Products Company) and those observers accompanying the whaling fleet with the authorization of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
4. Any communications between Japan and the whaling fleet, except personal messages which will be handled in a manner hereinafter described, will be transmitted or received by the Japanese coastal radio service only when addressed through the Communications Agent for the Whaling Fleet named in paragraph 3. A file copy of all messages sent or received through the Communications Agent will be retained in a readily accessible file by that Bureau.
5. Personal messages are authorized to and from members of the crews of the Japanese whaling fleet ships and their families in Japan. In Japan all such messages will be received by or transmitted from Radio Choshi or Radio Nagasaki of the Ministry of Communications Coastal Radio system. Copies of these messages will be retained in separately maintained files at these two stations. The Ministry of Communications will be responsible for the proper filing of all such personal messages at Radio Choshi and Radio Nagasaki.

6. a. Personal messages addressed to any crew member of the whaling fleet ships will be accepted at any regularly designated filing point in the Japanese Domestic Telegraph system and dispatched via the Japanese coastal radio system through Choshi or Nagasaki.

b. Personal messages from crew members of the whaling ships to addresses in Japan will be accepted by the ship of origin and transmitted to either Radio Choshi or Radio Nagasaki by the ships authorized in inclosure 1 on regularly maintained schedules. Such personal messages will then be delivered to any address in Japan through the normal domestic communications channels.

7. Communications, including personal messages, to and from authorized Allied observers accompanying the whaling fleet will be forwarded to or received from the Natural Resources Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, in Tokyo via the Communications Agent named in paragraph 3 above, and will be handled without charge.

8. Communications including personal messages, between Japanese nationals, to and from the whaling fleet, will be subject to all existing rules and requirements of censorship.

9. Messages pertaining to the navigation of Japanese whaling vessels, meteorological observations, and fishing data may be sent in the following codes:

- a. Telegraph code of the Bureau of Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry.
- b. The Nihon Suisan's telegraph code for fishery information.
- c. The Taiyo Gyogyo's telegraph code for fishery information.

Correct copies of these codes will be deposited with the Civil Censorship Detachment, G-2 Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers and with the Bureau of Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry.

10. With respect to the navigation of vessels, meteorological observations, and fishing data, the Japanese whaling fleet is authorized radio communication with the following:

- a. Other vessels of the authorized Japanese whaling fleet.
- b. Radio stations of the Japanese coastal radio service.
- c. Whaling vessels of other nations.

13. The Japanese whaling fleet will answer interrogations of non-Japanese coastal radio stations when so interrogated. All such communications will be brought to the immediate attention of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers' representative accompanying the expedition.

14. The Japanese whaling vessels may establish contact with other vessels or coastal radio stations to handle distress traffic in accordance with the General Radio Regulations (Cairo Revision 1938 and Atlantic City Convention Revision effective 1 January 1949).

15. Communication is permitted with any radio station when authorized by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers' representative accompanying the whaling expedition.

16. Direct communication between the Civil Communications Section, the Natural Resources Section, or any other interested section of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, and the Ministry of Communications and the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, regarding matters within the scope of this memorandum, is authorized.

1. Reference is made to memorandum to the Japanese Government, file AG 410.2(26 Jul 48)CPC/LP, SCAFIN 5968-A, 1 September 1948, subject, "Packing of Coins," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. As stated in reference 1(b), an inquiry was addressed to the United States Government in regard to the First War Powers Act.

3. The following reply has been received:

The First War Powers Act, as amended by Public Laws 322 and 671 does, in fact, apply to Japanese or to residents of Japan. Consequently, such persons may file applications for the return of property vested in the Office of Alien Property. The filing of such application by a Japanese national would serve no purpose, however, unless he qualified as a persecuted person under the provisions of Subdivision (C) or (D) of Sec. 32(a) (2) of the Trading With the Enemy Act [P.L. 671].

The final date for filing claims, formerly August 8, 1948 or within two years from the date of vesting, has been extended to April 30, 1949 or two years from the date of vesting, whichever is later.

It should be noted that in Public Law 896, 80th Congress, the policy was declared, contrary to that followed after World War I, that German and Japanese property should not be returned and that the proceeds of liquidation be covered into the Treasury. This, however, does not affect returns under Public Laws 322 and 671.

its custodial responsibility for preservation, maintenance
and eventual return of the remaining properties of the sub-





a. All right, title and interest in respect of any property outside Germany which is owned or controlled by any person of German nationality inside Germany

b. c. All right, title and interest in respect of any property outside Germany which is owned or controlled by those persons who were German citizens on or after 1 September 1939 and who at any time have lived abroad (continuously or intermittently) and who aided or attempted to aid Germany or her allies during the war or who assisted Germany or her allies in the preparation for war, but shall not apply to any citizen of any country annexed or claimed to have been annexed by Germany since 31 December 1937

d. All right, title and interest in respect of any property outside Germany which is owned or controlled by such categories of persons of German nationality as shall be designated from time to time by the German External Property Commission.





SUBJECT: Shipment of Funeral Urns and Personal Belongings
of Deceased Ryukyans

1. Reference is made to the following:

a. Central Liaison and Coordination Office Letter No. 3429
(FCR 93), subject as above, dated 2 October 1948.

b. General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied
Powers memorandum for the Japanese Government, AG 014.33 (29 Mar 47) GD,
SCAPIN 3527-A, subject, "Disposition of Funeral Urns and Personal Be-
longings of Deceased Ryukyans," dated 29 March 1947.

2. The Japanese Government is hereby directed to assemble the
funeral urns and personal effects cited in reference 1a at Kagoshima.
Separate rosters in triplicate will be prepared for the remains to be
shipped to Buckner Bay and to Naze as indicated in paragraph 4 below.
One copy of each roster will accompany each shipment. At least ten days
before shipment is made, two copies of each roster will be forwarded to
the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers with name of ship, expected
time of departure from Kagoshima, and expected time of arrival in the
Ryukyus.

3. The Japanese Government will arrange with the Naval Shipping Con-
trol Authority for Japanese Merchant Marine (SCAJAP) for assignment of
suitable shipping space on available shipping to the Ryukyus.

4. The funeral urns and personal effects will be consigned to the
Military Governor of Ryukyu Islands and will be delivered to the following
ports:

a. Buckner Bay, Okinawa, for natives of all the Ryukyu Islands,
except Amami-Oshima and smaller islands immediately adjacent.

b. Naze, Amami-Oshima, for natives of that island and smaller
islands immediately adjacent.

5. Bills of lading will be prepared and executed as directed in
paragraphs 4 and 5, reference 1b.

a. Coordinate with the Civil Property Custodian, Comptroller Division, Accounts Branch, on the issuance of CPC numbers, and

b. Paint the CPC number so issued on each individual ingot or parcel.
