MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Operations of Repatriation Reception Centers at Maizuru and Hakodate during the period 15 December 1948 to 1 April 1949

1. The Soviet Member, Allied Council for Japan, has advised that repatriation from the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and from Soviet-controlled areas will be suspended from 3 December 1948 until an indefinite date termed the opening of navigation in 1949.

2. The Japanese Government will:

a. Take such action to suspend reception center operations at Maizuru and Hakodate during the period 15 December 1948 to 1 April 1949, as is most consistent with economy, maintenance and security.

b. Be prepared, either upon thirty days' notice from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers or by 1 April 1949, if no other instructions are received, to resume operations at these repatriation reception centers with the following maximum monthly capacities:

Maizuru Reception Center 45,000
Hakodate Reception Center 30,000

c. Render to the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers a report by 10 January 1949, concerning the action taken in compliance with the provisions of paragraph 2 a and b.

1. Stated juridical persons are hereby authorized to use precious metals listed below. Precious metals will be released to listed users in the amounts shown, and consumed in manufacturing articles, all of which will be exported under authority of stated Japan Export Program (JX-P) case numbers:

a. 11,009 grams liquid gold containing 2,042.25 grams gold will be released from the pool of commercial products under custody of the Ministry of Finance, Japanese Government, to Nippon Toki K.K. for Japan Export Program case numbers JX-P 46442, 70038 and 70043

b. 23,500 grams silver bullion will be released from Japanese Government stockpiles to Nakamatsu Koshitsu Glass K.K. for Japan Export Program case number JX-P 70189. Inuishi Kikinzoku Kako Gomei Kaisha may be licensed as processor.

2. 3,816 grams liquid gold containing 717.44 grams gold will be released from the pool of commercial products under custody of the Ministry of Finance, Japanese Government, to Nippon Toki K.K., and consumed in manufacturing articles, all of which will be sold to Central Purchasing Office under authority of validated case number EX 17354.

4. Mr. Cooper Blyth has been designated as the authorized representative of the British Government to receive and give receipt for subject property.

5. The Japanese Government will designate by name an authorized representative to execute receipt forms on its behalf and will notify General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, of his appointment upon receipt of this memorandum.

6. The inclosed receipt forms consisting of one (1) original and five (5) copies are to be signed by the authorized representatives of the British Government and the Japanese Government and will be distributed as follows:

3. It is further directed that the engine of the "Kinshu Maru," which bears CPC-LEM No. 856, be retained in the custody of the Nankai Marine Products Company, Aburatsu-cho, Miyazaki Prefecture, pending further instructions as to its disposition. This property is not to be sold or transferred, and is to be properly protected from theft and damage.
4. A report as to the condition of the impounded engine and the feasibility of reconditioning it for further use is to be submitted to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, within 30 days of the date of this memorandum.

SUBJECT: Contracts Between the Petroleum Distribution Kodan and Petroleum Terminal Operators

1. Reference:

Letter, Central Liaison and Coordination Office, (CLCO), No. 3719 (2P), subject: Contracts Between the Petroleum Distribution Kodan and Petroleum Terminal Operators, 1 November 1948, inclosing application by the Economic Stabilization Board for approval of the contract to be entered into between the Petroleum Distribution Kodan and operators of petroleum terminals.

2. The contract as submitted for approval is in general satisfactory, but certain articles should be clarified or amplified before approval is granted.

3. The following suggested revision of the articles in question is furnished as a guide:

Article 2

The Kodan shall pay to the operator fair and adequate storage and operation fees in consideration of the affairs entrusted.

Amounts of storage and operation fees, time and method of payment, etc., shall be fixed by separate agreement between the Kodan and the operator. If such agreement is not reached within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this contract, the matter shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the provisions of Article 25.

Article 5

Add the following paragraph: "Should agreement still not be possible, agreement shall be determined by arbitration established in accordance with Article 25."

Article 11

The operator shall prepare such reports as the Kodan may require in respect to petroleum products, etc., (defined in Article 1) received, stored and shipped, quality analysis and such matters pertaining to the

quantities, quality, safety and security of the products handled as may be necessary to the Kodan's operations.

Article 12

The operator shall make reports to parties concerned and do other reasonable matters in the name of the Kodan if so authorized in writing by a Kodan official of proper rank.

Article 22

The Kodan may have a liaison representative at the operator's terminal, but this representative shall have no authority in the management and operation of the terminal. More than one liaison representative shall not be placed at a terminal without the consent of operator.

The person or persons assigned as liaison representative must be acceptable to the operator, but if rejected, the operator shall set forth to the Kodan reasonable grounds for such rejection.

Article 24

In the event the Kodan or operator violates this agreement, the other party may terminate this agreement forthwith by giving notice in writing to the principal place of business of the Kodan or the operator, as the case may be.

Article 25

In the event of any dispute between the Kodan and the operator in connection with the subject matter of this agreement, the same shall be referred for formal arbitration in accordance with the relevant Japanese law/s. The Kodan and the operator shall each appoint an arbitrator, and in the event that the said arbitrators cannot agree they shall mutually appoint an umpire whose decision shall be final. In case the arbitrators cannot agree on an umpire, _____* or any party appointed by him in his free discretion shall become such umpire.

Article 26

This agreement shall hold good until 31 March 1949 from the day of signing it. It shall be terminated by advance notice in writing either by the Kodan or operator not less than 30 days prior to the termination of the period or shall be extended for a further three months from 31 March 1949 by advance notice in writing not less than 30 days prior to the termination of the period either by the Kodan or operator providing both parties agree to the extension.

Memorandum

4. In the event that the operator is no longer in a position to act as custodian due to loss of ownership of the terminal referred to in Article 1 or other cause, the Kodan may terminate the contract forthwith.

4. The above revisions are self-explanatory as to purpose, and may be used as written, or may be rewritten as desired to accomplish the purpose. The contract as revised will be submitted to the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers for approval.

3. The Japanese Government is further directed to make a complete report of the rents and other income accruing from said property for the period from 30 October 1945 to date, and to ascertain by what authority Walter Helm or other persons unknown have collected said rents.

SUBJECT: Initial and Monthly Report on Expenditures Connected with Preservation, Maintenance and Administration of Vested German Property

1. The Japanese Government is directed to submit to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, a detailed report covering all costs entering into the preservation, maintenance and administration of all property formerly owned by "objectionable" and "non-objectionable" German nationals prior to 1 January 1949. Report will be prepared in a manner to segregate "cost of repatriation" from "other costs." This report will be submitted within thirty (30) days of receipt of this memorandum and will comply with directions in the succeeding paragraphs.

2. Upon submission of the initial report directed in paragraph 1 above, monthly reports, commencing with 1 January 1949, will be submitted as outlined below.

3. Each monthly report of the costs incurred in connection with German vested property will be submitted by the fifteenth (15th) day of the month following that covered by the report. The monthly report will indicate the cost of labor, materials, all other costs incurred, and will also include a brief description of the expenditures and the authority therefor. Supporting documents of the reported costs will be maintained by the Japanese Government in chronological accounting order to permit, at any time, an expeditious audit.

4. On each monthly report there will appear the total costs for the current month, the total costs previously reported and the accumulated totals to date.

5. The Japanese Government is directed to dispatch a representative of the Ministry of Finance to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian for the purpose of coordinating the action directed in subject memorandum.

"2. Effective this date and until further notice Japanese fishing, whaling and similar operations are authorized within the area bounded as follows: From a point midway between Nosappu Misaki and Kaigara Jima at approximately 43°23'14" North Latitude, 145°50'30" East Longitude; to 43° North Latitude, 146°30' East Longitude; thence to 45° North Latitude, 165° East Longitude; thence south along 165th Meridian to 24° North Latitude; west along the 24th Parallel to 123° East Longitude; thence north to 26° North Latitude, 123° East Longitude; thence to 32°30' North Latitude, 125° East Longitude; thence to 33° North Latitude, 127°40' East Longitude; thence to 40° North Latitude, 135° East Longitude; to 45°30' North Latitude, 140° East Longitude; thence east to 45°30' North Latitude, 145° East Longitude rounding Soya Misaki at a distance of three (3) miles from shore; south along 145th Meridian to a point three (3) miles off the coast of Hokkaido; thence along a line three (3) miles off the coast of Hokkaido rounding Shiretoko Saki and passing through the Nemuro Kaikyo to a point, 43°26'17" North Latitude, 145°48'03" East Longitude; thence in a south-easterly direction to the starting point midway between Nosappu Misaki and Kaigara Jima."

Applications for repatriation to the Ryukyu Islands will not be accepted after 2400 hours, 14 March 1949. Current Ryukyuan repatriation procedures will remain in effect until all applications received prior to 15 March 1949 have been processed and applicants duly shipped.

3. After 15 March 1949, individual Ryukyans may apply for permit for exit from Japan to travel at their own expense to the Ryukyus for compassionate reasons only. These applications will be submitted through local Military Government authorities to Commanding General, Eighth Army, for approval.

4. These applications will contain the following information:

- a. Name.
- b. Place and date of birth.
- c. Address in Japan.
- d. Present occupation.
- e. Statement of the compassionate reasons for travel.
- f. Destination (address).
- g. Desired date of departure.
- h. Probable port and means of departure.
- i. Any pertinent information which may have a bearing on the case.
