2. It is directed that the Japanese Government restore to the Owen Gomei Kaisha, in accordance with the provisions of reference 1a above, the land and buildings at No. 1623, Nishi-hirao, Higashi Tarumi-cho, Tarumi-ku, Kobe, and all movable properties which can be located and identified. Restoration will be made to Mr. V. T. Arratoon, agent for Mrs. Phyllis Irene Gregory (formerly Mrs. Phyllis Irene Owen). The receipt for restoration will be signed at the Hyogo Military Government Team Headquarters, Kobe, on 17 January 1949 at 1000 hours.

MEMORANDUM FOR: THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Collections of Staple Foods

1. Reference is made to:

a. Directive No. 3 (SCAPIN 47) from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, 22 September 1945.

b. Letter from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers to the Prime Minister, 19 December 1946.

2. Collection of the maximum practicable quantity of indigenous staple food crops is essential to provide all the Japanese people with a fair share of the available food and to achieve the objectives set forth in reference 1b and paragraph 9 of the inclosure thereto. Food control laws now in effect provide that collection quotas for staple food crops will be assigned prior to planting and that preplanting collection quotas will not subsequently be increased. The provision that preplanting quotas will not be increased makes it impossible to assure effective control of the limited available indigenous staple food supply.

3. In compliance with SCAPIN 47, the Japanese Government will:

a. Continue to take the necessary measures to maximize staple food production, including action to provide farmers an incentive to produce and deliver staple food crops.

b. Provide means for and accomplish the collection of maximum practicable quantities of available staple food crops, including the amendment or promulgation of necessary laws or ordinances to provide for the assignment of additional legally enforceable collection quotas to farmers at or near harvest time when crop conditions warrant.

4. Direct communication between the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, Japanese Government, and Natural Resources Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, is authorized for the implementation of this Memorandum.

6. The Japanese Government is directed to designate by name, an authorized representative to sign the receipt forms on its behalf, and inform General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian, of his appointment.

SUBJECT: Return of Seven Japanese Fishing Vessels From Korea to Japan

1. The Japanese Government is directed to prepare for dispatch to Pusan, Korea, a convoy of five vessels with necessary equipment, supplies and personnel for the purpose of effecting the return to Japan of seven (7) Japanese fishing vessels now detained at Fusan. Six (6) of these seven (7) vessels will require towing. One (1) official of the Japanese Government will be assigned to take charge of and to accompany this convoy.

2. This convoy will leave Shimonoseki, Japan, on a date to be specified by the Natural Resources Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers. It will proceed to Pusan, Korea, by the most direct route. Upon arrival at Pusan, the Japanese Government official in charge will effect the necessary liaison with the Port Commander, Fusan, Korea, for receiving and returning the seven (7) detained Japanese vessels. He will effect receipts for these vessels only, and will not enter into any other negotiations whatsoever while in Korea. The convoy will depart Fusan, Korea, immediately upon completion of necessary preparations, and proceed to Shimonoseki, Japan, by the most direct route.

3. All contacts with Port Commander, Fusan, Korea, necessary for the completion of this mission will be conducted by the Japanese Government official in charge. No other contacts with personnel in Korea by any other individuals assigned to this convoy are authorized by this memorandum. With the exception of the Japanese Government official in charge and his interpreter, no other individual assigned to this convoy will be permitted to disembark on shore while in Korea, except as required to prepare the seven (7) vessels for return to Japan.

4. The Japanese Government will apply to Commander, Naval Activities, Japan, for sailing authorization prior to departure from Japan. Vessels of the convoy will fly the modified International E flag.

5. Direct communication between Natural Resources Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers and the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, concerning matters within the scope of this memorandum, is authorized.

pending general decision as to their disposition.
In the circumstances, the settlement of Japan's
obligation to the Union must necessarily be held
in abeyance until such time as payment becomes
possible.

3. The second point raised by the Bureau's letter of
2 August 1948 relates to a possible change, in accordance
with article 23 of the Bern Convention for the Protection
of Literary and Artistic Works, in the classification of
Japan. General Headquarters considers exercise of the power
to change classification to be a matter within the discretion
of the Japanese Government and recommends that the Japanese
Government indicate its decision in its reply to the Bureau.

Reference is made to Memorandum for the Japanese Government, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, SCAPIN 5911-A, 11 August 1948, subject, "Office Space for Special Procurement Board," wherein the Japanese Government was directed to take immediate steps to provide adequate additional facilities required by the Special Procurement Board to insure efficient operation.

2. It has come to the attention of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers that the Japanese Government has taken no positive action to comply with the directive to which reference is made above.

3. In view of the Japanese Government's inaction and non-compliance in this matter, it is directed that adequate office space for the Special Procurement Board be allocated in the Teikoku Building located at 1-chome Marunouchi, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo, immediately after the building is vacated and released by the Occupation Forces to the Japanese Government. It is anticipated that this release will be made during the month of February 1949.

SUBJECT: Earthquake Reports and Tidal Wave Forecasts

1. Effective upon receipt of this memorandum, the Japanese Government is responsible that the Central Meteorological Observatory, Ministry of Transportation, furnish to the Occupation Forces, geophysical reporting and forecasting service as hereinafter specified.

2. a. In each instance that an earthquake of intensity 3, or greater, is recorded by the instruments of the Central Meteorological Observatory or its subordinate reporting stations, an immediate report will be made to the Occupation Forces. This report will contain the following information:

- (1) The intensity of the earthquake.
- (2) The location of the epicenter of the earthquake.
- (3) The time the earthquake occurred, expressed in Greenwich Mean Time.
- (4) Whether or not a tidal wave will result from the reported disturbance.
- (5) If a tidal wave is forecast to result from the quake, the estimated size of the wave and a forecast of what areas will be affected by the wave.

b. The required report will be prepared with the utmost speed consistent with technical accuracy, and will be transmitted by telephone to the Haneda Weather Central, Haneda Airport, telephone number Cargo 391. The telephone report will be confirmed in writing in English.

c. The Central Meteorological Observatory will be prepared to render the above required telephone report at any hour of the day or night. It is required that the telephone report be transmitted with minimum delay, and that the data necessary to make the report be assembled with the greatest urgency.

3. The written confirmation of the telephone report will be prepared in duplicate and will be delivered to the Central Liaison and Coordination Office at such time that it will be delivered to General.

3. The Japanese Government is directed to restore to the Government of the Republic of China, the 47,632 assorted hand tools listed in enclosure 1, which were looted from Shanghai, China, and which are at present in custody storage in the Osaka Arsenal Looted Property Warehouse.

4. The procedure outlined and specifications used in Annexes 4, 5, 6 and 7 of reference 1a above will be followed when dismantling, inner packaging, constructing exterior wooden shipping containers, marking and preparing of packaging list. However, the subject property will be packaged without the use of petroleum products which normally would be used in the packaging. The responsibilities of the Japanese Government
