MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Restitution of Hong Kong Coins to the Government of the United Kingdom

1. Reference is made to memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 386.6 (15 Feb 48)CPC/FP, SCAPIN 1858, 15 February 1948, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer and Delivery of Property being Restored to Claimant Nations under the Restitution Program," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. The Japanese Government is directed to receive approximately 11,060 Hong Kong coins from the custodian, U.S. Vaults, Bank of Japan, Tokyo and to restore same to the Government of the United Kingdom. Restitution will take place at the U.S. Vaults, Bank of Japan, Tokyo at 1000 hours, 20 December 1950.

3. Mr. C. Blyth and/or Mr. E. A. D. Smith have been designated the authorized representatives of the Government of the United Kingdom to receive and give receipt for the subject property.

4. The Japanese Government is to designate by name an authorized representative to sign receipt forms on its behalf and will notify the Office of the Civil Property Custodian, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers of his appointment.

5. The inclosed receipt form consisting of an original and five (5) copies are to be signed by the authorized representatives of the Government of the United Kingdom and the Japanese Government and are to be distributed as follows:

a. Original and one (1) copy to be returned to the Office of Civil Property Custodian, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers by the representative of the Japanese Government

b. Two (2) copies to be retained by the Government of the United Kingdom

c. Two (2) copies to be retained by the Japanese Government.

MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Restitution of Cotton Cloth to the Government of the Republic of China

1. Reference is made to memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 386.6 (13 Feb 48)CPC/FP, SCAPIN 1858, 13 February 1948, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer and Delivery of Property being Restored to Claimant Nations under the Restitution Program," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. The Japanese Government is directed to restore approximately 33,640 yards of cotton cloth and 400 cut pieces of cotton cloth, CPC Numbers 11586, 11587-001 and 11587-002, to the Government of the Republic of China. Delivery of the subject property is to be made on board ship at Yokohama. The name of the ship and the date of its arrival will be forwarded when this information is available. The property will be packaged for overseas shipment and each box marked as indicated in inclosure 1. Inclosed are L-4 forms which authorize the release of the subject property.

3. Mr. C. C. Lu and/or Mr. Thomas T. H. Tsao have been designated as the authorized representatives of the Government of the Republic of China to receive and give receipt for the subject property.

4. The Japanese Government is to designate by name an authorized representative to execute receipt forms on its behalf and will notify the Office of the Civil Property Custodian, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers of his appointment.

5. The inclosed receipt forms, consisting of an original and five (5) copies, are to be signed by the authorized representatives of the Government of the Republic of China and the Japanese Government and are to be distributed as follows:

MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Blocked Accounts of Hiroo Higasa and Hiroshige Suematsu

1. The Fuji Bank, Ltd., Moji Branch has reported that on 20 September 1945, an account was opened in the name of Hiroo Higasa for ¥29,596, and on the same day another account was opened in the name of Hiroshige Suematsu for ¥40,404. On 22 September 1945 Hiroo Higasa opened a second account for ¥900,000. On 12 November 1945, the Fuji Bank, Ltd. was placed on notice that these accounts, which were opened by bank drafts drawn upon banks in Korea, represented illegal transfer of funds from Korea to Japan.

2. The Fuji Bank, Ltd. has further reported that at the time of reorganization of the bank, these accounts were reduced to ¥15,000, ¥15,000, and ¥351,000, respectively.

3. It is directed that the Fuji Bank, Ltd. be instructed to restore these accounts to their original amounts, totalling ¥970,000, and that they be transferred to the SCAF Custody Account, Korean Funds, Bank of Japan. It is further directed that this headquarters be notified upon completion of this transfer.

SUBJECT: Manufacture of Hunting, Life-Line and Whaling Guns

1. References are:

2. No objection is offered to the licensed manufacture of the civilian type hunting, life-line and whaling guns described in reference la, above.

3. The possession, use and disposal of subject items and the ammunition required therefor shall be in accord with the provisions of reference lb, above.

4. In addition to the above, the Japanese Government will initiate appropriate action to insure that:

a. Manufacturers identify each firearm by metal-stamp serial number indenture.

b. All sales of firearms to authorized persons by manufacturers and/or dealers are registered with the appropriate Public Safety Commissions or Local Chiefs of Police.

SUBJECT: Deposits in the "Tripartite Trustee Account (Yen)"

1. Reference is made to:

a. Memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 306.7 (13 Oct 49)CPC/PLD, SCAPIN 2051, 13 October 1949, subject, "Notification that the United States, United Kingdom, and France are owners of certain Categories of Former German Property in Japan," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

b. Memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 123 (14 Feb 49)CPC/PLD, SCAPIN 6951-A, 7 November 1949, subject, "Deposits in the Tripartite Trustee Account (Yen) in the National City Bank of New York, Tokyo Branch," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. Memorandum for the Japanese Government, Reference 1b above is hereby rescinded.

3. Effective immediately upon receipt of this memorandum all Japanese Government deposits of funds owned or controlled by the United States, United Kingdom, and France under the provisions of the memorandum for the Japanese Government, reference 1a above, will be made to the "Tripartite Trustee Account (Yen)" in such depository as may be designated by the Civil Property Custodian.

4. In making deposits to the "Tripartite Trustee Account (Yen)" the Japanese Government will advise the Civil Property Custodian when a deposit is to be made. The Civil Property Custodian will inform the Japanese Government in which depository the deposit will be made and upon receipt of this advice the Japanese Government will follow the procedure outlined below:

a. The forms described in the memorandum for the Japanese Government, reference 1b above, are to be used. The "Schedule of Japanese Government Deposits" will be prepared in quadruplicate by a representative of the Japanese Government for each deposit. Reproduction of this form is authorized in pre-unnumbered quadruplicate sets. Each set will consist of:

- (1) The original or "CPC" copy
- (2) The second or "Bank" copy
- (3) The third or "Bank-CPC" copy
- (4) The fourth or "JG" copy

b. Signed deposit slips (the bank's ordinary deposit slips) in quadruplicate, will be secured from the bank covering each deposit.

c. The "CPC" copy of the completed "Schedule of Japanese Government Deposits", together with the original of the bank's signed deposit slip, will be delivered by a representative of the Japanese Government to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian, Accounts Division, immediately (same day) after deposits have been made.

d. The "Bank" and "Bank-CPC" copies, with bank's deposit slip attached, will remain with the bank.


e. The Japanese Government will retain the "JG" copy with a bank deposit slip for its own files.

f. The "Schedule of Japanese Government Deposits" will serve as the official Japanese Government report which has been directed to be filed in connection with deposits. No other report need be prepared unless there is some variance between the actual deposit and the amount directed to be deposited.

5. The Japanese Government, Ministry of Finance, is further directed to send a representative to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian, Accounts Division, within ten (10) days of receipt of this memorandum, to coordinate the procedures outlined in the preceding paragraphs.

6. Direct communication is authorized between the General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian, the designated depository, and the Japanese Government, Ministry of Finance, in all matters relating to the subject vested funds account.

SUBJECT: Procedures for Restoration of Patents, Utility Models and Designs to Allied Nationals

1. Reference is made to the following memoranda for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers:

a. File AG 072 (8 Apr 49)CPC/FP, SCAPIN 1990, 8 April 1949, subject as above

b. File AG 072 (8 Apr 49)CPC/FP, SCAPIN 1990/1, 16 May 1949, subject, "Procedures for Restoration of Patent Property in Japan to Allied Nationals."

2. It is directed that the Japanese Government, in executing "Certificates of Restoration" as described in paragraph 3d of reference 1b above, shall specify a "Time-limit for Payment of Patent Fee" which is not less than one hundred twenty (120) days counted from the "Date of Entry of Restoration."

3. The Japanese Government is also directed to apply retroactively the requirement contained in paragraph 2 above by amending the records of the Patent Agency where necessary to grant to owners of restored patent property the benefit of the specified minimum period for payment of the first annual fee after restoration.

4. The requirement contained in paragraph 2 above shall not apply in cases where a patent fee had become due within six (6) months before the applicable date of entry into war and had not been paid, nor will it in any way affect or delay the running of the six (6) months statutory period provided for in Article 69 of the Patent Law.

5. Direct communication is authorized between interested sections of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers and the appropriate ministries of the Japanese Government on all matters connected with this directive.





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

On the basis of oral information submitted to this Headquarters in compliance with referenced memorandum, the Uzami accounts totalling ¥837,085 were transferred on 16 October 1945 from the Fukuoka Branch to the Akasaka Branch of the Teikoku Bank, Ltd. Of this amount ¥418,542.50 was deposited in the name of Akira Uzami and ¥418,542.50 in the name of Hatsua Uzami.

3. The Ministry of Finance has subsequently reported that at the time of the reorganization of the Teikoku Bank, Ltd. on 1 March 1948, these accounts were reduced to ¥101,824.85 each.

4. It is directed that the Dai Ichi Bank, Ltd., successor to the Akasaka Branch of the Teikoku Bank, Ltd., be instructed to restore these accounts to their original amounts, totalling ¥837,085, and that this amount plus the interest earned on the same from the date of deposit be transferred in the name of Yoneichi Uzami to the SCAP Custody Account, Korean Funds, Bank of Japan. It is further directed that this Headquarters be notified upon completion of this transfer.



2. Investigation by the Office of Civil Property Custodian, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers resulted in the identification of the Studebaker sedan, serial No. 370W-323319, as the property of a Japanese national, and arrangements have been made to return the vehicle to the owner. However, efforts to establish ownership of the Buick and Lincoln sedans were unsuccessful.

3. The Japanese Government is directed to conduct a thorough investigation to determine whether these two vehicles can be identified as the property of Japanese nationals, and to report the results thereof within thirty (30) days of the date of this memorandum. Should it be impossible to obtain the necessary information from the usual sources, classified advertisements in local newspapers may be effective. If Japanese ownership cannot be established, L-2 forms impounding the vehicles as unidentified looted property are to be submitted to the Office of Civil Property Custodian, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers by the Japanese Government.

1. Reference Memorandum for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, AG 004(26 Jun 50) FIB, SCAPIN 2106, 26 June 1950, subject: Operation of Internal Airline Within Japan.

2. Paragraph 2, subparagraph g, is amended as follows:

"g. Subject to approval by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, the licensee may enter into contracts for the transport of mail, freight and passengers within Japan. Such contracts may be expressed in, and licensee may receive in payment therefor, currencies other than Japanese yen, subject to such regulations respecting such currencies as may be applicable."

3. Paragraph 3 is added as follows:

"3. In addition to the foregoing, the Japanese Government may license any Japanese controlled juridical person to engage in business activities involving internal airline transportation provided neither the Japanese Government nor Japanese nationals participate in the development, manufacture, assembly, ownership or airborne operation of civil aircraft."

4. Paragraph 4 is added as follows:

"4. Rates for the transport of mail, freight and passengers shall be fixed by the Japanese Government subject to approval by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers."

MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Importation of Goods from Germany and Other Countries Manufactured Under or Carrying Vested Industrial Property Rights

1. Reference is made to memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 386.7 (13 Oct 49)CPC/PLD, SCAPIN 2051, 13 October 1949, subject, "Notification that the United States, United Kingdom, and France are Owners of Certain Categories of Former German Property in Japan," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. The term "former German property," in referenced paragraph 1 above, within the meaning of this memorandum, includes patents, utility models, designs, trade names and trade-marks as property owned by the United States, United Kingdom and France for whom the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers is trustee.

3. For the purpose of permitting importation to Japan from the Federal Republic of Germany and other countries of goods which carry vested trade-marks or trade-names legally applied in such countries, the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, as trustee for the Three Powers who are the owners of such trade-names or trade-marks in Japan, will, upon application, give consideration to the granting of individual licenses to importers in Japan to import and offer such goods for resale in Japan. The foregoing procedure is also applicable to goods produced lawfully in such countries under inventions or processes which have patent protection in Japan now owned by the above mentioned Three Powers. Such licenses will be non-exclusive, royalty free and revocable at will and will normally be granted provided that:

a. It does not conflict with any effective exclusive agreement to which the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers is a party by virtue of his trusteeship

b. It will not result in the previous German owner of the vested industrial property right obtaining a degree of control, directly or indirectly, over such property right considered undesirable by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers

c. The firms outside the Federal Republic of Germany, which use the vested marks on their products, have been either

- (1) legitimate manufacturers or users under the marks in their home countries since before 7 December 1941 or
- (2) have become legitimate manufacturers or users under the marks since 7 December 1941.

4. Attention is directed to the fact that the license referred to in paragraph 3 above does not grant permission to apply the trade-marks or trade-names in Japan nor to make the patented articles nor to use the patented process in Japan, but merely authorizes the importer to use, sell and advertise the imported articles in Japan.

5. Licenses will be granted in accordance with the following procedures:

a. Applications therefore will be made to the Patent Agency, Ministry of International Trade and Industry, Japanese Government and will include the following information:

- (1) Regarding patents, utility models and designs
 - (a) Name, address and nationality of applicant (importer)
 - (b) Name and address of manufacturer or supplier of goods to be imported
 - (c) Registration number, including title and classification, name of registered owner (former German owner) and a short description of the invention or process
 - (d) Description of goods manufactured under such right and the total amount to be imported
- (2) Regarding trade-marks and/or trade names
 - (a) Information required by 5a, (1) (a) and (b) above
 - (b) Registration number, registered owner, classification and photostatic copies or an exact copy, in duplicate, of the trade-mark or trade-name affixed on the products to be imported
 - (c) In cases where goods are imported from manufacturers or suppliers in any country other than the Federal Republic of Germany, evidence that such firms have been either
 - (1) legitimate manufacturers or users under the marks in their home countries since before 7 December 1941 or

- (2) have become legitimate manufacturers or users under the marks since 7 December 1941.

b. All applications must be typed or clearly printed in English in quadruplicate copies

c. The Patent Agency will transmit such applications, together with a statement certifying the correctness of information contained therein insofar as can be determined from the official records of the Patent Agency, to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, for appropriate action

d. General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers will within a reasonable period of time forward to the Patent Agency for transmittal to the applicant, formal approval or disapproval of the application.

6. The Japanese Government will not be required to take any action under Article 34 of the Trade Mark Law in those cases where the importers are granted permission to import and offer for sale in Japan goods which carry vested trade-marks and/or trade names legally applied in the country from which such goods are imported.

7. The Japanese Government is directed to take necessary steps to advise all importers and foreign exchange banks in Japan of the contents of this memorandum and that import licenses will not be granted in the future for importation of goods described in paragraph 3 above without presentation of:

a. A statement that the articles to be imported have not been manufactured pursuant to a patented invention or process which has patent protection in Japan and/or do not carry trade-marks or trade names that are now owned by the Three Powers or

b. The license from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers to use, sell and advertise such articles in Japan.

8. The Japanese Government is further directed to submit to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers a copy of the filed statement referred to in paragraph 7a above, together with a copy of the corresponding application for the import license.

9. Direct communication between the interested sections of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers and the appropriate agencies of the Japanese Government is hereby authorized in the implementation of the instructions contained herein.


