Act for Eliminating Discrimination Against Persons with Disabilities (Overview)

Article 4, Basic Act for Persons with Disabilities

Basic principle: Prohibition of discrimination

Paragraph 1: Prohibiting behavior that violates rights, such as discrimination against people with disabilities

No person shall discriminate against persons with disabilities, violate their rights, or harm their benefits because of disabilities.

Paragraph 2: Preventing violations of rights due to failure to eliminate social barriers

If persons with disabilities who need the elimination of social barriers exist and the expenses for the elimination are not excessive, requisite and rational consideration needs to be given to such elimination in order not to violate the stipulation of the preceding paragraph by failure in such elimination.

Paragraph 3: National governments attempts to raise the nation's awareness and disseminate knowledge

To raise the nation's awareness of the prevention of behavior that violates the stipulation written in Paragraph 1 and to disseminate knowledge, the national government shall collect, arrange and present information necessary for preventing such behavior.
