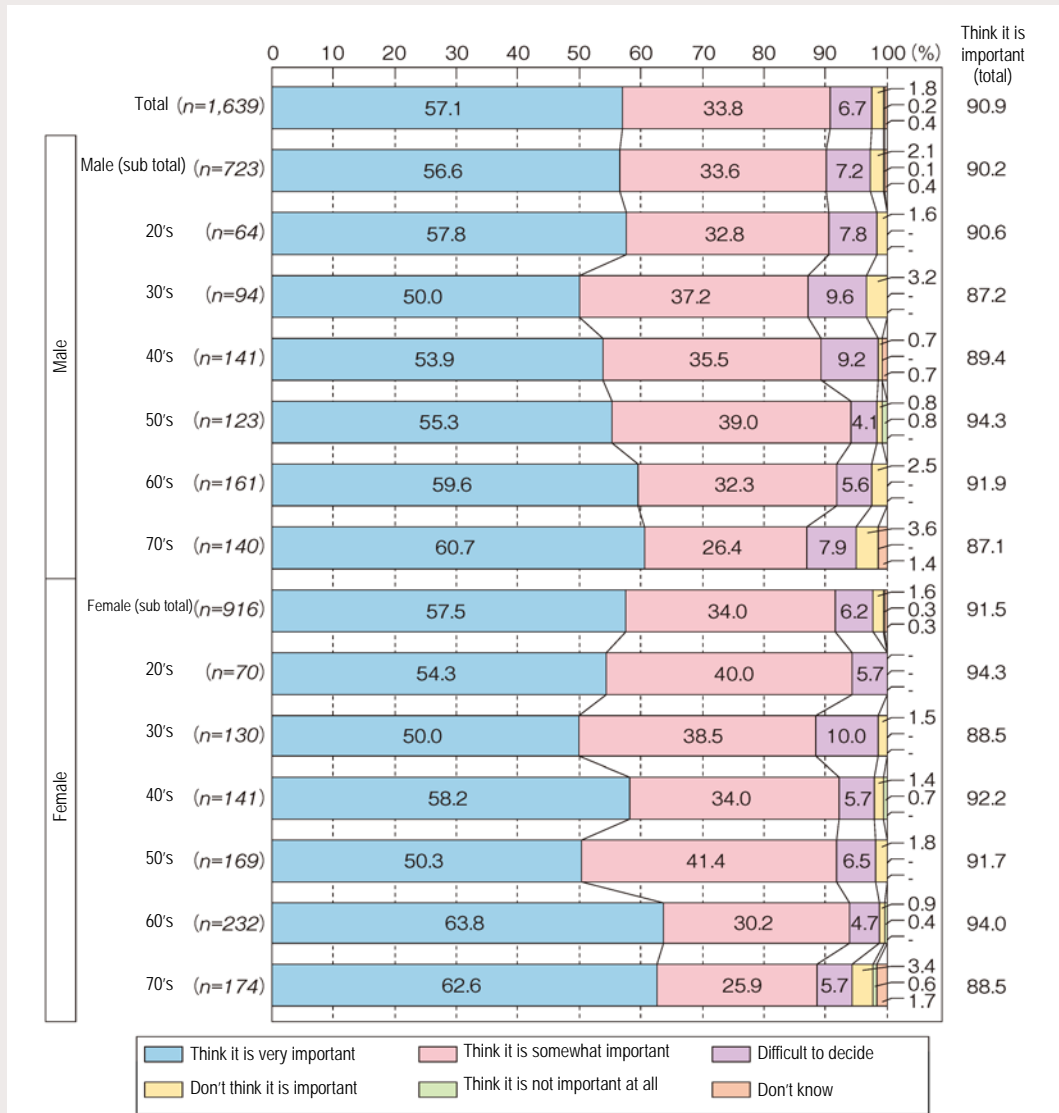

Willingness to assist or interact with mothers and their young children when in public

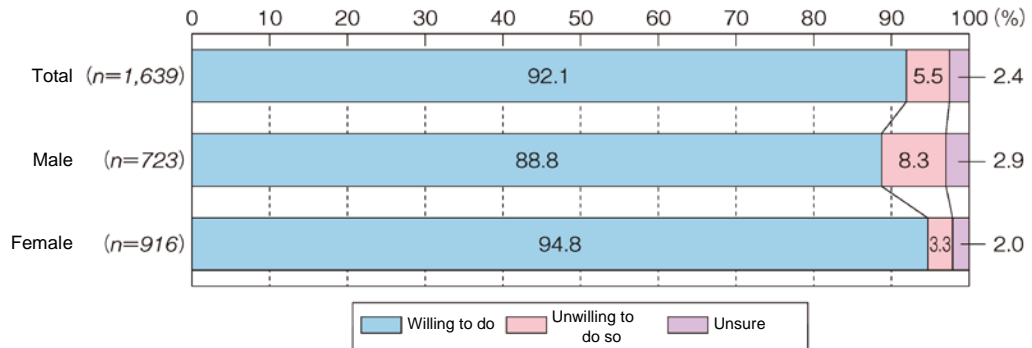
