BERSATU coordinated the Brunei Darussalam—Republic of Korea Youth Exchange Program, fostering friendship and understanding between 12 youths from different educational backgrounds. Additionally, they organized the Hibikiya Workshop in collaboration with the Japan Embassy, providing participants with the opportunity to play traditional instruments. Through fundraising efforts, they aimed to enhance the local students' understanding of environmental issues and the importance of recycling.



Malaysia transitioned to the endemic phase of COVID-19 on April 1, 2022, allowing Malaysians to return to a near-normal life after nearly two years of battling the pandemic. In response, Malaysia has prioritized human capital development and SI, organizing several programs in 2022 and 2023. In 2022, SI Malaysia initiated the SSEAYP Roundtable

Programme (SRPRO) 2022 in February with 150 participants. In March, we conducted the Essay and Curriculum Vitae Assessment and Camp Selection Session for Participants of the International Youth Exchange Programme 2022. July saw SI Malaysia's annual general meeting and the election of a new executive committee for 2021–2024. In October, we held the Pre-Conference Training SSEAYP Youth Conference 2022. Closing the chapter on the 2022 calendar, on December 4th, we successfully organized SICO 3.0 with the theme "Mental Health: Facing an Unequal World."

In 2023, SI Malaysia appointed me once again as a member of the panel for the Essay and Curriculum Vitae Assessment Session for Candidates of the Youth Opportunity and Exchange Programme 2023, followed by the Selection via the Assessment Centre Youth Opportunity and Exchange Programme in March. In May, SI Malaysia hosted the Eid Fitri Open House for alumni members and held family gatherings in Kuala Lumpur. In October, SI Malaysia organized the Sabah Retreat—Land Below the Wind—for its exco members. In July, we collaborated with primary and secondary schools to raise awareness about bullying issues (SK Jalan Cochrane, SK Sentul 1, and SK Kiaramas). We also supported SK Kepong Baru in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM), which equips youth with logical thinking, holistic approaches, and 21st-century skills. STEM plays a crucial role in driving economic growth, creating jobs, and addressing environmental and global challenges.



**Prominent Alumni: YBhg Kolonel (K) Dato' Juhari Haji Janan (MaPY 1983)**, born in 1961, is a Malaysian business executive who became the Deputy Chairman of Jetama Sdn Bhd, based in Kota Kinabalu, while his political career was based in Sandakan as Division Chief of Parti Gerakan Sabah DUN59 Sukau. In 2015, he established KABESA Sabah and Labuan and became the first president of KABESA Sabah and Labuan until the present. Currently, he is also holding a position as Vice President I of SSEAYP International Malaysia and President of Bangsa Sungai Sabah (SABAS).
